

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons over the age of twenty-one years and citizens of the State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Texas Nonprofit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is CAMELOT TOWNHOMES ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation, no part of the income of which is distributable to any members, directors, trustees or officers and no part of the net earnings of which shall inure to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To provide a means of administering, preserving and maintaining a condominium project to be known as Camelot Townhomes, all in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Condominium Act of the State of Texas, Article 1301a, Vernon's Annotated Texas Statutes, and the Condominium Declaration for the project filed or to be filed pursuant to the Act in the Condominium Records of El Paso County, Texas;
2. Subject to part 4 of the Texas Miscellaneous Laws Act, to exercise all powers of a nonprofit corporation as set forth in the Texas Nonprofit Corporation Act and to do all other things necessary and proper to accomplish the purposes set out

herein and to administer and enforce the provisions of the Condominium Act and the Declaration for said project.

ARTICLE FIVE

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 330 Eubank Drive, El Paso, Texas 79902, and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at such address is Charles C. Wood.

ARTICLE SIX

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is three and the names and address of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:




